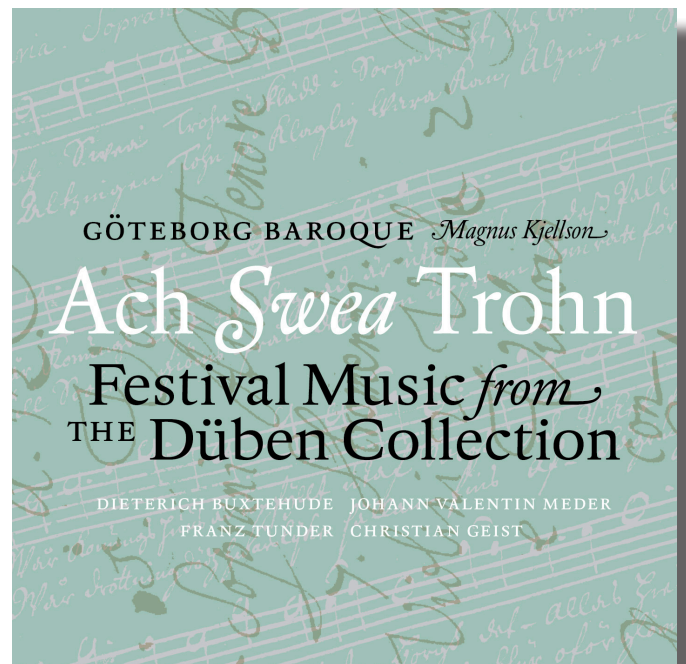

Göteborg Baroque Magnus Kjellson *Ach Swea Trohn – Festival Music from the Düben Collection*



FOLLOWING THE SUCCESS of their debut CD, a Buxtehude portrait (FRCD 033), **Göteborg Baroque** now presents a CD with music from the Düben collection at Uppsala University. The collection from the years around 1700 consists of some 2,500 handwritten works of music and more than 120 printed pieces. Many of the pieces in the Düben collection have not been preserved elsewhere, which makes this collection so outstanding. Among the composers on this CD are **Franz Tunder**, **Johan Valentin Meder**, **Christian Geist** and **Dieterich Buxtehude**.

Göteborg Baroque is a Swedish ensemble made up of 22 instrumentalists and 8 singers. The intimate cooperation between singers and musicians has given Göteborg Baroque a unique sound which has attracted much attention. **Magnus Kjellson** is the founder and artistic director of the ensemble. He has studied at the Sweelinck Conservatory in Amsterdam and received his artist diploma in organ performance at the Academy of Music and Drama, Göteborg University.

For the recording of this CD, the North German Baroque organ in Örgryte New Church in Göteborg was used as a continuo instrument. The organ was built as an international research project to better understand the work of the German builder Arp Schnitger.
